ATS Pacific New Zealand's carefully designed itineraries feature three ranges of hotel accommodation, a choice of Standard, Superior and First Class categories, which have been selected because of convenience, service, and value for money. With each itinerary a traveller can choose to travel in a rental car on a Self Drive basis, or on daily tourist class coach services on a Seat-in-Coach basis. All services are pre-booked.

Itineraries

These holiday itineraries range from short stays in the North Island only, through to extensive programmes that include both the North and South Islands of New Zealand and that will see you visit New Zealand's top points of interest. DAY 1 - ARRIVE AUCKLAND
